IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

AVOID DROWNING RISK, READ AND FOLLOW ALL INSTRUCTIONS. Failure to follow all instructions may result in injury or drowning.

1. **WARNING** – Keep children away, entrapment possible.
2. **WARNING** – Children or objects cannot be seen under spa cover.
3. **WARNING** – Remove cover completely before entry of bathers – entrapment possible.
4. **WARNING** – Stay off cover, it will not support weight.
5. **WARNING** – Non-secured or improperly secured spa covers are a hazard.
6. Keep the spa covered and locked when not in use.

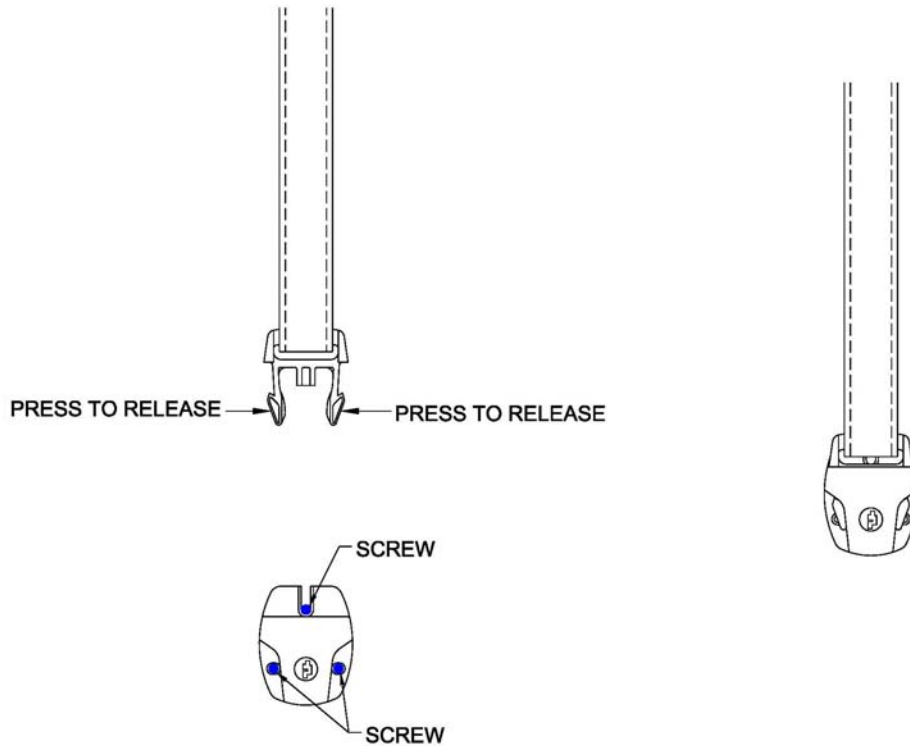
SAFETY MARKINGS

Each spa cover has been provided with a minimum of two warning markings that outline safety precautions. These warning markings should be permanently placed in a location that is visible to the users. These markings have been sewn on permanently next to each of the handles. These warning markings should be inspected periodically for premature wear and/or legibility issues. Replacement markings can be obtained from:

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Position the spa cover on the spa.
2. Pull the strap tightly downward, then press the buckle against the spa skirt.
3. While holding the buckle against the skirt, release the strap from the buckle, and mark the three mounting locations onto the skirt.
4. Use the supplied screws to secure the buckle onto the skirt.
5. Repeat Steps 2-4 for the remaining straps.





Therm-Rite™ Spa Cover by L.A. Spas

L.A. Spas warrants the cover to be free from defects in materials and workmanship for a period of: 2 years on the vinyl cover and 1 year on the foam core. This warranty is extended only to the original consumer from the date of delivery and terminates upon transfer of ownership.

How to obtain warranty when defect becomes apparent during the warranty period:

- Upon discovery of any defect, notify L.A. Spas immediately by visiting www.laspas.com and click on contact us where you will submit your claim to warranty via e-mail.
- Additional information may be needed which could include pictures.
- Freight to and from L.A. Spas for a repaired or replaced skin is to be paid by the purchaser. Proof of purchase must accompany the defective spa cover.
- The cover skin will be repaired or replaced, if upon inspection the defect is determined to be covered by the warranty.
- The replacement or repaired spa cover skin will be returned to the consumer within thirty (30) days of L.A. Spas' receipt of the defective spa cover.

Warranty Exclusions:

- Broken foam inserts and steel channels are not warranted.
- Normal fading and minor deterioration.
- Damages, such as but not limited to, snow, wind, falling objects, animals or any other acts of God.
- Spa cover has been subjected to any alterations, misuses, abuses, or if any repairs are attempted by anyone other than L.A. Spas.
- Damages or discoloration as a result of improper water chemistry maintenance, including excessive chlorination, bromination, or contact of chemicals onto cover.
- Defects caused by a component, or part that is not part of the cover, such as a cover lifter.
- Chafing or wearing holes due to dragging on rough surfaces or sharp objects.
- Torn handles – handles are designed to open the cover only, not for carrying or removing the cover from the spa.
- Torn tie-downs – tie-down straps are designed to secure the cover only, not for opening or removing the cover from the spa.

L.A. Spas does not cover consequential or incidental damages including damage to property or injury arising from the use of this product. Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of consequential or incidental damages, so the above exclusion or limitation may not apply to you. There is no other warranty expressed or implied except as stated herein.

Care and Maintenance:

Avoid exposing cover to excessive chemicals and remove cover when adding chemicals. Maintain proper spa water chemistry. Any texture change or extreme discoloration of bottom material indicates chemical burn. Keep cover clean, free of dirt and debris. Remove leaves or other debris to avoid color leaching. Avoid water and snow from accumulating. Use a mild detergent and water solution to clean the vinyl portion monthly. Avoid scraping the cover on rough surfaces. Avoid jerking or pulling the cover, especially when vinyl is soft from heat to prevent threads from tearing the vinyl. Always unfasten all hardware before opening cover. Gently fold down cover onto itself. Do not sit, walk, or lay on the spa cover. Avoid placing any heavy objects on the cover. If the foam is cracked or damaged, replace immediately to avoid further damage to vinyl cover and maintain proper performance.
